SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum 5-1 - Establishing New Senior ROTC Relationships

1. Reference:

a. HQDA, DAPE-MP memorandum (FY22 to FY24 U.S. Army Accessions Mission Letter), 17 Sep 2021.

b. USACC PAM 145-1-1, (Procedures for Establishing, Reclassifying of Disestablishing a Senior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (SROTC)), 10 April 2019.

c. USACC Memorandum, subject: Commanding General Guidance for Senior ROTC Program Expansion (Change 3), 28 January 2020.

2. As a result of the DAG1 commission mission and resource reduction, no new Host unit, Extension unit or Cross-town relationships can be established unless approved by the United States Army Cadet Command (USACC) Commanding General (CG).

a. No new relationship or expansion unless it supports Army and USACC outcomes.

b. New relationships must be resource and manpower neutral or have Army offsets.

c. The CG retains the authority to establish or reactivate crosstown relationships.

d. Guidance to establish new SROTC relationships is outlined in CC PAM 145-1-1.

3. This policy supersedes reference 1c, and remains in effect until rescinded by the CG.
