

COLONEL ALLEN L. KEHOE

Brigade Commander 2nd Brigade, U.S. Army Cadet Command, Join Base McGuire, New Jersey

Colonel Allen L. Kehoe commissioned into the United States Army through North Georgia College and State University as an Infantry Officer in 2001.

As a Lieutenant, he served as a Brigade Reconnaissance Troop (BRT) Platoon Leader in B Troop 9th Cavalry, 3rd Brigade, 4th Infantry Division. Following this assignment, he was selected and served as a Rifle Platoon Leader and Company Executive Officer in C Company, 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment. Following the Captains Career Course, he served as a Battalion Assistant S3 and Company Commander in 1st Battalion, 503rd Parachute Infantry Regiment, 173rd Airborne BCT. In 2009, Kehoe served as a Company Commander, C Company, 5th Ranger Training Battalion.



After Command and Staff College, he served as Battalion Operations Officer, 2nd Battalion, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division and the Brigade Operations Officer for 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division. Next, Kehoe was assigned to United States Central Command where he served as the Deputy Branch Chief for Current Operations (Ground Operations) and went on to serve as the Iraq/Syria Lead portfolio manager for CENTCOM Commanders Action Group (CAG). In 2017, Kehoe moved to FT. Myer to initially serve as the Deputy CDR of the 3d US Infantry Regiment and next as the Battalion Commander for 1st Battalion, 3rd US Infantry Regiment (The Old Guard). Following Battalion Command, Kehoe served as Executive Officer to the Director of Program Analysis and Evaluation (PAE), HQDA-G8. In 2021, Kehoe was assigned as an Army War College Fellow to the Fletcher School at Tufts University in Boston, MA. Most recently, Kehoe served as the Deputy Commander of the 75th Ranger Regiment at Fort Benning Georgia before taking command of 2nd BDE Cadet Command in the summer of 2023.

Operational Deployments include: one deployment to Iraq (2003-2004) and four deployments to Afghanistan (2005, 2006, 2007-2008, 2013-2014). Kehoe's military education includes the Infantry Officer Basic Course and Advanced Course, United States Army Command and General Staff College, Joint and Combined Warfighting School (JPME2), Army War College Fellow Tufts University, Mechanized Leader, Airborne, Basic Instructor Training Course, Tactics Certification Course, and Ranger Course.

Kehoe's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Achievement medal, Iraqi Campaign Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Expeditionary Medal, National

Defense Service Medal, NATO Medal. Unit Awards include the Joint Meritorious Unit Award, Valorous Unit Award, and the Meritorious Unit Citation. He is authorized to wear the Ranger Tab, Parachutist Badge, Combat Infantryman's Badge, and the Expert Infantryman's Badge.

Kehoe is married to the former Ms. Christie Williams of Plains, Georgia and also a graduate of the University of North Georgia. They have one daughter.
