SUBJECT: Cadet Summer Training (CST24) Policy Memorandum 15 - Cadet Cell Phone Usage

- 1. Reference. Army Regulation 600-20, Army Command Policy, 24 July 2020
- 2. Purpose. To outline authorized cell phone usage.
- 3. Cadets are <u>only authorized</u> to use cell phones in the garrison area when they are off duty. The garrison area consists of the the Disney Training Complex footprint. Cadets are considered off duty when they have completed all scheduled training for the day.
- 4. Cadets are not authorized to use cell phones in any training areas, including training areas in or around the barracks area. Cadets will be specifically required to secure all mobile communication devices during Land Navigation training and the entirety of the Field Training exercise. Cadets will be provided a sealable storage container to secure their equipment. Platoon OCTs (Observer, Controller, Trainer) will inspect all sealed containers daily. Any Cadet found to have broken the seal on their storage container will be subject to administrative action, to include dismissal from camp due to honor violation. Platoon OCTs are the approval authority for any emergency situation for cell phone use outside of the garrison area.
- 5. Cadets will not utilize their mobile devices to take photos or videos while in the training environment.
- 6. Cadets are responsible for securing their cell phones when not in use. Cadet Command assumes no liability for lost, stolen, or damaged cell phones.
- 7. Cadets who violate this policy may be referred to a Leader Development Review Board (LDRB) at the discretion of their Task Force Commander.
