SUBJECT: Cadet Summer Training (CST25) Policy Letter 14 - Fort Knox
Warrior Restaurant Dress Code

1. References.

a. Army Regulation (AR) 670-1, "Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia," 26 January 2021.

b. AR 30-22, "Army Food Program," 17 July 2019.

2. Purpose. To establish standards of dress and appearance for Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to all military and DOD civilian personnel who are dining, working, or visiting Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants.

4. Requirements and Policies. Personnel entering or utilizing Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants will wear attire in good taste and maintain a respectable standard and appearance. To maintain reputable standards, the command has established the following dress code for all Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants:

a. Personnel will always wear closed-toed shoes and shirt. No authorization of flip flops or shower shoes by personnel.

b. No authorization of ripped or soiled clothing or clothing that presents an unhealthy or unclean appearance.

c. Personnel will not wear outer garments as shirts intended as undergarments. Personnel will not wear tank tops, blouses without bras, sleeveless shirts exposing the armpits, or see-through shirts.

d. No authorization of denim jeans with holes, cut off shorts, shorts that are too suggestive, or pants that sag to a point of revealing the backside/undergarments.

e. No personnel will wear headgear, civilian or military, except authorized food service personnel, food inspectors, military police under arms, and personnel

wearing religious headgear while in civilian attire or in military uniform in accordance with AR 670-1. No wearing of hair curlers, scarves, bandanas, do-rags, or anything of this nature.

f. No wearing of clothing with slogans or patches which are sexually suggestive, contain profanity or are in bad taste

g. Personnel must cover tattoos that are extremist, indecent, sexist, or racist.

h. Soldiers may wear summer/winter Physical Fitness Uniforms when dining, working, or visiting Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants.

i. No wearing of mixed uniforms or any part of the uniform with civilian attire, to include including motor pool coveralls ACU / OCP tee-shirts, or plain brown tee-shirts (excluding the PFU jacket).

j. No weapons are authorized in Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants except for law enforcement personnel while on duty.

k. Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants authorizes the wearing of military face camouflage.

5. All personnel entering Fort Knox Warrior Restaurants will adhere to these guidelines, or they will receive guidance to leave the facility.
