Colonel Jonathan Post is from Ramsey, New Jersey. He received his commission from the United States Military Academy in 2002 and served as a Field Artillery officer in the 173rd Airborne Brigade before being selected for Special Forces training in 2006. He earned his Green Beret in 2008 and served in various command and staff positions with 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne) from 2008 – 2017. He was then assigned to the Joint Special Operations Command's Interagency Task Force - National Capital Region, where he served as a liaison to the Federal Bureau of Investigation in New York City, as the Director of Operation Gallant Phoenix, and as the Commanding General's representative to the Department of State. He commanded 2nd Battalion, 2nd Special Warfare Training Group (Airborne) in Fort Bragg, North Carolina from July 2020 – June 2022 and 1st Infantry Battalion, 3rd Security Force Assistance Brigade in Fort Cavazos, Texas from July 2022 - June 2024.



Colonel Post holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from West Point, a Master of Science degree in Defense Analysis from the Naval Postgraduate School, and a Master of Strategic Studies from the United State Army War College.
