5. If you have a concern, you are encouraged to present it first to your chain of command or civilian supervisory chain and afford them an opportunity to resolve it.
6. Subordinate commanders and supervisors at all levels will be as receptive and responsive to the needs of their subordinates to the extent possible, and fully engaged, when practical, to resolve problems.
